Intended use:

Storage: 2-8°C

Normal Equine (Horse) Serum Blocking Buffer is used in immunohistochemical staining procedures to block nonspecific staining when the host species of the secondary antibody is Equine (Horse).

Kit components:

Solution contains 0.05% NaN3.

Recommended protocol:

- 1. Apply 100uL or enough volume of Normal Equine (Horse) Serum Blocking Buffer on tissue before adding primary antibody and incubate for 10 minutes at room temperature.
- 2. Blot off Normal Equine (Horse) Serum Blocking Buffer Solution (Do not rinse) and add primary antibody.

Precaution:

Wear gloves and take other necessary laboratory safety procedure.

Storage:

Store at 2-8°C.
